Receive an extra box of Girl Scout cookies upon submission of your entry.

Entries will be judged at NOON on Sunday July 11th

First Place: 7 boxes of cookies. Runner up: 3 boxes of cookies.



Rules:

→ You must be a Raymond NH resident

→ You have to make a baked good of your own creation including the cookies provided to you.

→ If the recipe yields more than 6 servings the extra servings may be kept by the baker.

Baking Event 2021 Entry Details and Judging Criteria

Entry Details

1. Bakers may pick up the selected package of Girl Scout cookies on Thursday July 1st at the Town Concert on the Common concession stand from 6-7pm.
2. Only entries submitted with an approved entry form will be judged.
3. Bakers will receive a second package of Girl Scout cookies when entry is submitted for judging.
4. All entries must use a package of Girl Scout cookies.
5. All entries must be baked and turned in for judging on the day of the contest.
6. Only one entry will be allowed per family or address.
7. Store bought items will not be judged. The Girl Scout cookies may be the only prepared items in an entry.
8. Six (6) single-serve entries must be turned in by the baker at the Girl Scout campsite on the Town Common on Sunday July 11th at 11am.
9. The contest for this year will be limited to a maximum of 20 entries.
10. Entries will be assigned a number and will only be identifiable by the entry number and name of entry. Baker name and age category will not be revealed until after judging.
11. Two additional boxes per entry will be donated to the elderly.

Judging Criteria

1. Town volunteers, unrelated to the bakers, will be the judges.
2. Judges will be selected or appointed by Girl Scout Troop 10435.
3. Each entry will be judged by 6 judges.
4. Entries will be judged upon the following criteria to receive up to 30 points per judge:
 - Appearance (up to 6 points) Before tasting. The overall look of your entry. How enticing is it? How neat is it?
 - Aroma (up to 4 points) Before tasting. How does it smell? Is it pleasing? Is it tempting?
 - Flavor (up to 6 points) After tasting. How does the flavor of your baked good remind the judges of Girl Scout cookies? If there are other flavors are they balanced or is one too powerful? Does it live up to its enticing smell?
 - Texture/Consistency (up to 6 points) After tasting. Is the entry evenly and completely baked?
 - Overall (up to 8 points) After tasting. How does the judge feel overall about your entry compared to other entries?
5. Judges may not consult with others while scoring.
6. A total score for each entry will be calculated by adding up the scores for each of the criteria listed above.
7. The highest total score will win the First Place prize of 7 packages of Girl Scout cookies (one each of Tagalongs, Trefoils, Thin Mints, Samoas, Do-Si-Dos, GS S'mores, and Lemon Ups).
8. The second highest score will win the Runner Up prize of 3 packages of Girl Scout cookies (one each of Tagalongs, Thin Mints, and Samoas).
9. In event of a tie between the top entries, the total scores of each judging category will be compared in the following order. First, Overall score, second, Appearance and Aroma combined, third, Flavor and Texture/Consistency combined.
